Hotel Safari at the Hotel Atlantic Kempinski Hamburg: Culinary House Tour behind the Scenes of a Grand Hotel

Hamburg, Germany, March 2010: Century-old ladies usually have many a story to tell and know a lot of secrets. This also applies to Hamburg's "Grande Dame", the Atlantic Kempinski Hotel on the Outer Alster. It is right there, in the so-called "Phantom Room", next to the famous globe over which already James Bond alias Pierce Brosnan escaped from his persecutors in the film "Tomorrow Never Dies" that the very special house tour starts with a glass of champagne and a breathtaking view over Hamburg. Past the little "Spitzweg Room", where Max Liebermann and Oskar Kokoschka once worked and which is nowadays German rock star and permanent hotel resident Udo Lindenberg's private workshop, the path leads on over steep stairs and hidden corridors into rooms and corners that are usually never looked into by hotel guests. To strengthen body and soul, refreshments are served on the way at places especially steeped in history, along with amusing anecdotes. At the end of the tour waits the culinary highlight with a main dish and dessert served in the gourmet Restaurant Atlantic.

The "Atlantic Hotel Safari" arrangement includes two nights in a double room, breakfast buffet with view over the Alster River, the "Hamburg Card" featuring many benefits such as cost-free travel by public transport, a big harbour tour in an original Hamburg barge and the "Atlantic Hotel Safari" with 5-course-menu and selected drinks.
