Le Grill and Garden @ Kempinski – Hybernská Street 12
Cuisine: International, Czech

From the elegant interiors of its outlets to the very design of its menus, the restaurant at our hotel features the best elements of exemplary dining in Prague. V Zátíší – Liliová Street 1
Cuisine: International, French

Piano Nobile at Villa Richter – Staré zámecké schody 6
Cuisine: International, French / Stunning view of Prague

Bellevue – Smetanovo nábřeží 18
Cuisine: International, French / Stunning view of Prague

U Modré Kachničky (At the Blue Duckling) – Nebovidská Street 6

French Restaurant at the Municipal House – Nám. Republiky Sq. 5
Cuisine: International, French

This most elegant establishment, which has large windows with a view out to the Republic Square, serves some of the best international cuisine in Prague. Enjoy also the impressive art-deco interior with gold and crystal chandeliers hanging from a very high ceiling.



La Finestra / Aromi – Platnéřská str. 13 / Mánesova Street 78
Cuisine: Italian

Two of the Prague's best Italian restaurants are by the Charles Bridge and Vinohrady district, where chef owner Riccardo Lucque prepares the specialties of his home region, Marche.



La Degustation Boheme – Haštalská Street 18
Cuisine: Czech degustations

The team of chefs and patissiers led by Oldřich Sahajdák prepares tasting menus consisting of seven courses supplemented with seven amuse-bouches. The restaurant presents traditional meals of Czech culinary art prepared from carefully selected ingredients according to traditional Czech recipes following modern culinary techniques.



U Malířů – Maltézské nám. 11
Cuisine: International

Upon entering the restaurant, visitors will be enchanted by the historical atmosphere and magic of old times. The restaurant was established in 1543, and amongst its “barflies” was Emperor Rudolph II who came to dine there on recommendation from his royal staff, who were sent to find the most hospitable restaurant in the area. A combination of traditional cuisine, high quality wines, and historical interior will enable visitors to enjoy the special atmosphere.



Samurai – Londýnská Street 73
