






SULAWESI: TRIBE AND ITS DIVERSITY

Also known as Celebes island, Sulawesi is one of the four greater Sunda islands. Rare species such as nocturnal tarsiers and maleo birds live on the island, roaming the dense jungles of the island. From the famed spicy cuisines from the Northern parts of the island, to the elaborate funeral ceremonies unique to the Toraja highlanders, Sulawesi offers colourful cultures and natural abundance.



ARRIVAL RITUAL

Wedang Saraba becomes the welcome drink during the months of October and November. An infusion of ginger and other spices such as cinnamon, lemongrass, and clove, this drink is also mixed with palm sugar and milk. This drink helps warm the body and fight flu and fever; it also strengthens the immune system and stamina. Adding to the experience, The Apurva Kempinski Bali's dedicated lobby ambassadors will welcome guests in one of the traditional outfits of Sulawesi.











In collaboration with Tanamera Coffee, premium coffee beans from Toraja are offered at the Deli, along with various delicacies such as Tinutuan - rice porridge with sweet potato, cassava pumpkin, corn and spinach. Another dish, Binte Buluhuta, is a sweet, sour and spicy corn soup with "Belimbi" and chilli, served with tuna, mackerel and prawn.







Koral Restaurant

The culinary journey continues with Koral Restaurant's specialty dishes. Unique tastes inspired from the traditional specialties around Sulawesi Islands are presented, including Ikan Dole from Buton, Ayam Nasi Likku, Pallu Kacci and Konro from the Bugis tribe.

Guests are presented with a line of seafood or meat that is prepared based on the Sulawesi style of cooking. To highlight Sulawesi's culinary identity, Bai Yun has taken the Coto Makassar, a specialty from this city, South Sulawesi, and incorporated it as a special soup base. Very rich in flavours by the use of beef broth and different spices, this special soup will provide a special hot pot experience for all visitors.

Treatments such as bedda lotong scrub that was used to pamper the noble women of North Sulawesi, and Balia healing wisdoms from Kaili tribes in Palu are offered, introducing Sulawesi's holistic knowledge to the guests.





FIRE MEDITATION WITH BALIA HEALING WISDOM

Balia is a healing tradition from Kaili tribes in Palu. Kaili tribes believes that Balia is the ritual that asking to the anchestor to cure the desease and this ritual is usually performed by indigenous people who believe fire can ward off disease. That said, this ritual is closely related to the royal family.

ASHA CURATED BOUTIQUE AND GALLERY & SPECTACULAR COLLABORATIONS


