



— ROYAL BORN —

Dating back to the 17th century, Çırağan Palace Kempinski Istanbul is the only Ottoman Imperial Palace and Hotel situated on the Bosphorus, one of the world's most important waterways. Facing Asia, with enchanting views to the historical peninsula, it offers the glamour of a genuine Ottoman Palace in a city where East meets West, Europe meets Asia and history meets the contemporary.

Following a full restoration and the addition of a modern hotel building that includes elegant rooms, restaurants and meeting rooms, the hotel and palace opened in 1991 under the leadership of Europe's oldest luxury hotel group, Kempinski Hotels. The historical landmark also marks the beginning of an exciting new chapter as the legendary hotel has recently redesigned the guestrooms, suites, lobby, and restaurants in the hotel building, offering a world of exquisite redesigns blended with history and grandeur.

The legendary hotel has 317 rooms and suites, including 11 private palace suites in the historical Çırağan Palace. In addition to its magnificent outdoor event spaces that host prestigious local and international events, 20 meeting rooms offer advanced technology and unparalleled comfort to meet the exacting standards of visiting guests.





A HISTORY —OF TIMELESSELEGANCE

In the mid-19th century, on grounds that were previously home to royal gardens, a summer villa and a marble palace, Sultan Abdulaziz commissioned the Balyan family – famous architects and veterans of palace design during the Ottoman Empire – to construct the imperial palace. In an ornate style befitting the Sultan, only the finest marbles, porphyries, mother-of-pearl and other valuable materials from around the world were utilised in the construction. Çırağan Palace eventually opened its doors in 1871, ushering in a new era of historical prominence, both as a home to the Sultan and as a host for important government meetings.

In 1910, not long after a historically significant meeting of the Ottoman Parliament, a devastating fire destroyed the interior of Çırağan Palace. Completely dilapidated, with no clear direction on how to best rejuvenate the property, the historical grounds remained uninhabitable and largely abandoned for many decades; albeit, occasionally seeing use for other activities, most notably serving as the home stadium for Beşiktaş football club.

Finally, in 1991, following a complete restoration and the addition of a modern hotel building, Çırağan Palace Kempinski Istanbul was reborn and opened its doors to guests yearning to marvel at its historical splendour.

Istanbul, the unique city that straddles the continents of Europe and Asia, fulfils all desires with its beauty and history. For thousands of years, Istanbul has been a symbol of greatness, magnificence, royalty, glory and elegance.

Enjoying a fairy-tale place in history, Istanbul is one of the world's most fascinating and attractive cities, offering thrilling experiences, natural beauty, rich historical and cultural heritage and luxurious accommodation.

To that end, Çırağan Palace Kempinski Istanbul, ideally situated on the European shore of the Bosphorus between the districts of Beşiktaş and Ortaköy, is close to the city's main attractions, upscale shopping areas such as Nişantaşı, and only a short drive to the historical peninsula and the business districts of Levent and Maslak. Both Istanbul Airport and Sabiha Gökçen International Airport, located 42 km (26 miles) and 48 km (30 miles) away, respectively, are only a one-hour drive, door-to-door.


- Drawing inspiration from historical palace gardens, the entrance harmonises with nature and foliage.


Çırağan Palace Kempinski Istanbul, an iconic symbol of the city, has embarked on an extraordinary journey into a new era, harmoniously blending its rich historical heritage with modern elegance through a comprehensive redesign project in the hotel building. Guided by the vision of esteemed Ottoman Art Expert Serdar Gülgün and Toner Architects, the entire hotel building has been transformed into a timeless masterpiece.

Classic design elements, infused with innovative flair, transport guests to different eras, immortalising the momentous past within the hotel's walls. The new guestrooms, suites, and restaurants in the hotel building at Çırağan Palace offer timeless Ottoman

glamour; royal and authentic sophistication is reflected in design touches that take inspiration from the Ottoman Empire, including the use of mother-of-pearl, ebony inlaid furniture, hammam-style marble bathrooms, and Ottoman era-infused fabrics and furniture inspired by the Ottoman art of Ebru.

A majority of the E-shaped hotel guest rooms have an amazing sea view. These rooms overlook the Asian coast and, depending on the wing, may offer views of the historical peninsula, including the Maiden's Tower or the Bridge. Freshly redesigned hotel rooms facing the Bosphorus or Yıldız Park are spacious and comfortable, with private balconies set in refined luxury.





REDESIGNED ROOMS & SUITES IN THE HOTEL

TRADITIONAL MAGNIFICENCE OF THE OTTOMAN EMPIRE: THE REDESIGNED ROOMS AND SUITES EXUDE GRANDEUR AND OPULENCE REMINISCENT OF THE OTTOMAN EMPIRE. THE DESIGNERS' ARTISTIC EXPERTISE IS INFUSED WITH MODERN ELEMENTS, CREATING A HARMONIOUS BLEND OF TRADITION AND INNOVATION.

- The corridors draw inspiration from ostentatious Ottoman tents, adding a regal touch to the design.
- Different room colours are used to symbolise the historical periods of the Ottoman era. Headboards adorned with Çintemani represent the dynasty and wealth, while the tulip-patterned motifs reflect the tulip period. Mother-of-pearl furniture adds a touch of luxury and elegance to the rooms and suites.
- The marble bathrooms pay homage to Turkish bath traditions, offering a luxurious bathing experience. Featuring grey-on-grey inlaid marble walls, the bathrooms showcase the Ottomans' expertise in creating intricate marble patterns.

- The coffered ceilings with geometrical patterns and the straw-patterned carpet draw inspiration from Ottoman palaces and traditional carpets.
- The seat designs are inspired by Ebru, the ancient Turkish art of marbling, adding an artistic touch to the rooms.
- Newly redesigned hotel rooms feature Atelier Rebul x Çırağan Palace special bathroom amenities inspired by a unique fragrance exclusive to Çırağan Palace Kempinski Istanbul. The range includes custom-made shampoo, conditioner, hand and body lotion, and soap. Crafted with 100% renewable energy for sustainability, these products come in responsibly produced, 100% recyclable aluminium tubes, reflecting the hotel's environmental commitment.





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




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ROYAL OTTOMAN SUITE & PASHA SUITE










— PALACE SUITES —



Çırağan Palace Kempinski Istanbul has 11 suites in the historical palace that offer a royal experience in line with local tradition, featuring large sash windows, high ceilings, and captivating views of the Bosphorus, the historical peninsula, the palace courtyard or the park. maisonette-style duplex suites, which exude a cosy and residential warmth, enhanced by the sophisticated style and soft colour palettes. — THE SULTAN SUITE —



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The palatial Sultan Suite, almost 400 sq m (4,305 sq ft) in size, is located on Floor 2 of the historical Çırağan Palace, overlooking the Bosphorus.

One of the largest and most expensive suites in the world and equipped with advanced technology and features, the Sultan Suite is an ideal accommodation to feel the soul of this historical palace that Ottoman sultans once called home.

The Sultan Suite has colossal, beautiful doors, two decorative fireplaces, regal chandeliers, columns, and replicas of paintings by the famous palace artist, Fausto Zonaro. Floorto-ceiling windows with extraordinary

Bosphorus views combine with the best of contemporary and classical Ottoman architecture to recreate the splendour of the original palace.

All of the imperial-style furniture with Ottoman motifs and accessories, which were made in Türkiye, dates back to the 19th century.

The Sultan Suite has proudly received numerous awards and continues to receive recognition from the world's leading publications and organisations as one of the most luxurious and expensive suites in the world.

Upon arrival at the historical palace, guests will be carried back to Ottoman times as they are welcomed by a private butler to the sounds


of classical music and served a traditional Ottoman drink and a sherbet in the foyer of their lavish suite accommodation.




















— HISTORICAL — TURKISH HAMMAM

On the orders of Sultan Abdulaziz, Çırağan Palace was constructed from 1863 to 1871 using the best-quality marble brought from abroad. Used frequently as a meeting place for the Ottoman Parliament, a devastating fire raged through the complex in 1910, sparing only the external walls, some columns, and a large part of the Turkish hammam. The surviving original parts of the Turkish hammam remain to this day, mainly comprised of engraved wall decorations and columns, which have been vigorously preserved. Fortunately, the other area destroyed by the fire has been restored to its original glory.

With its towering ceiling, architecture and engraved ornaments, the Turkish hammam continues to be a special venue for guests visiting Çırağan Palace Kempinski Istanbul. The distinguished atmosphere of this classical Turkish hammam creates an exceptional venue for unique gatherings and special events.


INFINITY POOL

— REMARKABLE — **FACTS**

The word "çırağan" means "full of light" in Persian. The word became synonymous with the palace during the Tulip Period, when torches decorated the gardens at night during "Çırağan Festivals."

Çırağan Palace's priceless, ornamented doors were made by Vortik Kemhacıyan, then worth 1,000 gold coins each. Sultan Abdulhamid II gave one of these doors to his friend, His Imperial and Royal Majesty German Emperor and King of Prussia, Friedrich Wilhelm II, who admired the gift so much that it was put on display in the Berlin Museum.

Rare marble and mother-of-pearl were imported from all over the world for the construction of the palace. Waterfront construction alone cost 400,000 Ottoman liras, and during the construction of Çırağan Palace, which began in 1863 and was completed in 1871, 2.5 million gold coins were spent.

The grounds that surround the hotel is 47,600 sq m (512,362 sq ft), which is the equivalent of approximately eight football stadiums.

Beginning in the early 1930s, in the old palace gardens, Beşiktaş football club built what became known as Beşiktaş Şeref Stadium in honour of the football club founder. Although the Golden Gate extended 7-8 m (23-28 ft), the close proximity to the water made balls kicked into the Bosphorus a common occurrence. Beşiktaş continued to use the stadium for all home matches until 1948.



Çırağan Palace Kempinski Istanbul continues to serve as the inspiration and setting for many books, such as I am Çırağan, Letter from a Stranger and The Imperial Harem of the Sultans, all of which are still on shelves today.

Çırağan Palace Kempinski Istanbul is home to the only registered helipad on the Bosphorus.

The Palace Suite area has an array of unique, historical handmade carpets.

Çırağan Palace Kempinski Istanbul features the biggest Viennese Baroque-style grand chandelier in the world, weighing a massive 2.7 tonnes, bearing 232 lamps. Crafted in aluminium pieces that are cut and polished by hand, the unique style is reminiscent of the grand chandeliers found in the Spanish Riding School in Vienna. Although scaffolding had originally been used to clean the chandelier, a servo has now been added, with routine maintenance and cleaning performed every six months.
