— THE HOTEL —

SINDHORN KEMPINSKI HOTEL BANGKOK

Sindhorn Kempinski Hotel Bangkok promotes wellbeing and connecting with nature from the very centre of a fast-moving and vibrant city. The building’s design incorporates light and air. Spacious rooms and suites are designed for intuitive comfort, with floor-to-ceiling windows and private balconies for natural light, as well as soundproofing against exterior

and interior noise. Culinary creations draw inspirations from the natural world. The hotel has the city’s most complete spa and fitness centre, with 4,000 sq m spread over three floors and dedicated to therapies and treatments, exercise regimes, yoga, and Pilates. Wellness emanates from every corner, every motion of Sindhorn Kempinski Hotel Bangkok.

LOCATION

Bangkok, one of the world’s most visited and exciting cities, has an emerald-green gem of a neighbourhood, stretching from the embassy district to the venerably verdant Lumpini Park. Right between Langsuan and Tonson, is Sindhorn Village, a residential community centre that extends the park’s greenery. Within the village, surrounded by lush tropical gardens, Sindhorn Kempinski Hotel Bangkok is home.

LOBBY

Guests entering the hotel discover a marvellous expanse, featuring elegant arches forming a 15-metre-high vaulted atrium that fills the lobby with light and air, full of freshness and space. Glass walls bring a sense of the outdoors into the interior, with the garden greenery blending into the lobby décor of ferns and flowers. Natural earth tones complete the palette, complementing the garden ambience and natural fragrances.





— ACCOMMODATION —

Every room at Sindhorn Kempinski Hotel Bangkok is surprisingly spacious, starting with the Grand Deluxe Room, which, at 66 sq m, is the largest entry-level guestroom in Bangkok. Floor-to-ceiling windows flood every room with natural light and provide extensive views of the city, park, and Sindhorn Village's verdant gardens. Each room has its own private balcony, and soundproofing, such as double walls and solid doors, help guests enjoy a restful night's sleep.

Room décor uses natural colours to create a bright and welcoming ambience. Adding a distinctively Thai touch are photographs of the

ornate motifs and decorative tiles from Wat Ratchabophit, built in the 1860s under the commission of King Rama V. This Buddhist temple is greatly significant as it features an east-meets-west aesthetic approach that includes gilded Italian architecture, Buddhist art in Sri Lankan style, inlaid mother-of-pearl decorations, and colourful benjarong ceramic accents.

Certain room categories provide guests with exclusive access to the rooftop Executive Club Lounge, offering complimentary breakfast, all-day refreshments, afternoon tea, and evening cocktails.

— MEETINGS & EVENTS —

Thoughtfully designed private meeting rooms, each with abundant natural light and outdoor balcony access, comprise the 268 sq m indoor space and a one-of-a-kind outdoor garden venue. Grand Sindhorn interconnects to form the complete indoor venue, an elegant function space with a view of garden greenery, ideal for hosting formal company meetings, casual social events, or unforgettable celebrations

for up to 100 persons. Grand Sindhorn can be divided into three smaller, self-contained rooms. The lavish outdoor garden venue, at 436 sq m, provides a magnificent space for pre-dinner cocktails or to commemorate special occasions. Home to over 200 plants and rare trees, the garden features firefly light art for a magical experience.



— GARDEN —

Time-honoured trees that have witnessed the neighbourhood's flourishing generations welcomes visitors to the tropical gardens and lotus pond creating a lush and cooling oasis in the centre of downtown Bangkok. Pathways meander through the greenery, and there is a feeling of openness and nature, inviting yoga

and meditation sessions in peaceful niches. Gardens and hotel blend together in a natural embrace, the flora being an integral part of the design, visible through the glass walls of the lobby and restaurants. The terraces are inviting dining and event spaces, with an added touch of romantic magic at night.

The evergreen tropical atmosphere blending interior spaces and gardens are ideal to commemorate life-changing events as two lives and families merge. Traditional Thai ceremonies or contemporary celebrations shine

— FLOURISH —

Using high-quality ingredients sourced from sustainable farms and suppliers all over Thailand, Loukjaan by Saneh Jaan is a new-

generation dining experience that returns to its roots and presents the essence of Thailand's culinary heritage.

Inspired by its MICHELIN-Starred sister restaurant, Loukjaan by Saneh Jaan elevates classic favourites with unique ingredients and presentations, such as Banana Blossom Salad with pulled chicken or Stir-Fried Thai Milkweed Flowers with fermented pork and prawns. So many familiar flavours are served with delicious elegance and inventive style. — LOBBY LOUNGE —

With its architectural design showcasing spaciousness and natural light, the Lobby Lounge is a serenely beautiful place, drawing on garden calm inside and out. A perfect spot to relax after a long journey or a hectic day or to meet friends and colleagues, visitors can settle in at the Lobby Lounge for a light meal

from the extensive all-day menu, a reviving coffee, or a very distinctive afternoon tea. The culinary team works with a skilled Tea Master to offer three afternoon tea sets daily, including a signature vegan set, featuring a selection of fine teas and organic herbal infusions grown by local farmers.

— FIREFLY BAR —

Firefly Bar is a cosy, jazz lounge that features the soft glow of intimate lighting and the embrace of deep armchairs, opening to outdoor seating on a leafy garden terrace. This is a home of fine vintages, organic wines, premium

spirits, modern mixes, and classic cocktails. Tucked away in its own fragrant corner is the exclusive La Casa Del Habano cigar lounge, with an impressive whisky library and a handsome selection of Cuban cigars.



— KI IZAKAYA —

Ki Izakaya embraces the convivial comfort of Japanese izakayas with Kempinski's signature style and elegance. Inspired by the famous alleyway izakayas of Hozenji Yokocho in Osaka and Shinjuku Golden Gai in Tokyo, Ki Izakaya combines the urban eclectic feel and relaxed vibrancy found in these social centres. Cheerful lighting, cosy seating, and cityscape panoramas create a welcoming ambiance for

friends and colleagues to raise a glass or two while enjoying bites of Japanese favourites.

Ki Izakaya features an impressive menu of small plates and one-dish meals to enjoy and share along with an extensive selection of highballs, whiskies, and sakes, as well as draught and craft beers.

— WELLNESS —

The hotel's entire Floor 9 is devoted to wellness. Sindhorn Wellness by Resense has been meticulously crafted by leading global wellness expert Resense, providing 4,000 sq m of treatments, facilities, and services to empower guests to achieve their optimal wellbeing. The spa has 26 treatment rooms, including private suites, and offers a bespoke collection of treatments and advanced therapies focused on detoxification, rejuvenation, and prevention.

The pool area extends the spa experience with a thermal area that has an authentic Moroccan hammam, bio and salt saunas, a cold chamber, aroma steam room, Rasul mud room, and a tepidarium lounge where guests can relax as they look out over Bangkok. As the final touch, a 25-metre saltwater infinity swimming pool immerses with the green surroundings and city views.

— FITNESS —

Fitness enthusiasts will enjoy Asia's first hotel boutique fitness facilities. Spread across two floors are dedicated workout studios, such as a live and virtual cycle studio featuring world-leading Les Mills classes, a HIIT (High Intensity Interval Training) studio offering the latest CrossFit and virtual workout systems,

exercise studios for a wide range of yoga and high intensity classes, and a Pilates studio with the latest equipment from Balanced Body. Resense's highly trained experts are on hand and ready to guide every guest to achieve their fitness goals.





— SURROUNDING AREAS —

Connecting nature and the city, Sindhorn Village is a new community that integrates modern architecture with an extension of the enormous leafy-green expanse of Lumpini Park. Created as a residential sanctuary in the centre of Bangkok, under the concept of Living in the Park, Sindhorn Village incorporates

large garden areas that provide a living, breathing natural environment. Langsuan, a prime thoroughfare and prestigious address, runs alongside Sindhorn Village, while the village itself has its own open-concept shopping venue, Velaa.
