WINTER SNOW DRIVE



DIFFERENT DRIVING DESTINATIONS: WHERE CARS TAKE A VACATION

Discover the beautiful landscapes and breath-taking scenery of the Swiss mountains together with charm of the iconic village of St. Moritz.

ROUTE 1

Zurich – Andermatt – St. Gotthardpass – Ascona – San Bernadinopass – Spluegenpass – Chiavenna – Maloja Pass – St. Moritz

From Zurich, up to the Gotthardpass, the journey will take you along Lake Zug and Lake Vierwaldstaetter where you will have already few places for nice stops and breaks.

In Andermatt you will tackle the St. Gotthardpass, which is the first alpine pass and will give an experience what these roads can offer you.

Through Ascona in Ticino, the journey will lead you over the San Bernardino and Spluegen passes until you reach Chiavenna in Italy. Through the Malojapass which is breath-taking and fun to drive you will reach finally St. Moritz and the beautiful Swiss mountains.



ROUTE 2

Albulapass – Thusis – Bergün – La Punt

The Albulapass – the road from Thusis through Bergün leads to La Punt in the Inn Valley and offers great scenery and a beautiful mountain panorama with a diversified route.

Milano – Lake Como – Lecco – Varenna – Bellano – Chiavenna – St. Moritz

Take the exciting route with Italian flair from Milano along Como Lake, crossing through the charming town of Chiavenna and up the curvy mountain roads of the Maloja Pass.

Coffee Breaks

Hidden mountains huts and panoramic sports serve Engadin specialities to the guest who come their way.



ROUTE 3

Ofenpass – Prad – Passo dello Stelvio – Bormio – Tirano – Berninapass

From the Lower Engadin all the way to Zernez. From there, the journey will take you over the Ofenpass all the way into South Tirol. From Prad in the region of Vinschgau you can drive over Passo dello Stelvio, which at 2.757 metres is the highest mountain pass in Italy and the second highest asphalt mountain pass in the Alps until you reach Bormio in the region of Veltlin. In Upper Veltlin, at the entrance to the Puschlav Valley in Tirano your journey will take you over the Berninapass back into Engadin. A breath-taking tour through the Swiss mountains
